Rethinking New Futures of Justice: Law Beyond Its Limits A Critical International Law Summer School

By examining the key components of international justice –its social constructions, law’s technocratic potential, the political economy and affective life—the course is committed to exploring the actors engaged in the making of international criminal law regimes as well as the contexts within which such forms of international law are made to intervene.

Through a combination of lectures, class trips and workshops, students and faculty are offered an opportunity to share their research and critically reflect on some of the most pressing concerns of the contemporary period – especially in the Global South.

Applicants should submit the following application items:

- (a) a cover letter explaining the value of this summer school for your research
- (b) a 350-500 word abstract describing your research interests
- (c) a Curriculum vitae (CV) or resume
- (d) two letters of recommendation

The inclusive course cost is USD \$2,000. This includes accommodation, meals, tuition and registration fees, and ground transportation for class trips.

Air transportation to Rwanda and transfers to the hotel and airport are not included and are the responsibility of participants. A registration deposit of \$500 is required at the time of acceptance and will be deducted from the total course cost.

The Summer School will be structured with thematic lectures in the morning and graduate student workshops in the afternoons. The working language of the Summer School will be English, with French translation as needed.
